Dear RDE Parents,

As you know, this year, the FBISD Board of Trustees approved the adoption of Renaissance 360 (Ren 360) – a universal screening tool in reading and math for our students. A universal screener is a brief, computer-adaptive assessment that is given to students in grade levels K-10 to determine students' current skills and to identify gaps in learning. In addition, the use of a universal screener allows campus teachers, specialists, and administrators to examine the effectiveness of classroom instruction to meet the needs of all learners.

As a reminder, the following students take these assessments three times a year in September, January, and April to monitor student growth over time. Campuses can choose to assess additional students as well.

- All K-3 students complete the Early Literacy Renaissance 360 screener
- All K-5 students complete the Math and Reading Renaissance 360 screeners
- All 6-10 students who did not achieve the "Approaches" performance level on the previous year's Math and Reading STAAR assessments complete the Renaissance 360 Math and Reading universal screeners

If your student has taken one of these assessments, you can now view your student's Ren 360 Parent Score Report in Skyward – Family Access. Included with this letter is a job aid that provides the steps to access this report. If you would prefer a paper copy of your student's score report, please notify your student's campus.
