Arrival and Dismissal Information

Welcome to Barrington Place Elementary-- Meadows home away from home! As you can imagine, combining schools is no easy task, but we are up to the challenge!

We have worked closely with the Sugar Land Police Department, FBISD Transportation, FBISD Police, and our facilities department to make sure that arrival and dismissal procedures are safe and efficient.

By working with these resources, we have determined that the best way to approach arrival and dismissal will be to designate a Meadows arrival and dismissal area (Alston side due to the large number of Meadow's family residences and the traffic flow study) and a Barrington Place arrival and dismissal area (back of the school with a newly added parking lot and traffic loop to clear cars off the street for buses, day cares, and cars to travel more efficiently).

PLEASE REVIEW THE MAPS AND EXPECTATIONS BELOW IN ORDER TO MAKE THIS A SUCCESS!

Doors will open at 7:35 a.m. to receive students <u>who have cleared the</u> <u>temperature check and wellness screening.</u>

Please see the Wellness Screener for your child to complete each day in Skyward Family Access prior to coming to school.

<u>ARRIVAL</u>

PLEASE Review the CAR RIDER LINES MAP BELOW

School starts at 8:10 a.m. Students may arrive beginning at 7:35 a.m. They will be sent to their grade level hallway to wait until being dismissed to their classes only after completing of the temperature check and wellness screening in their cars with parent. Staff is available each morning to help students find their way to their classrooms. We ask that no students be left on campus prior to 7:35 a.m., as no staff will be available to supervise. Safety is our number one concern here.

Carpool Lines (Arrival)

We will have a safe and efficient carpool line. We realize many are in a hurry in the morning, but we require you to follow a few rules and traffic laws to protect our students:

- STUDENTS MUST REMAIN IN CARS WITH PARENTS UNTIL ALL SAFETY AND WELLNESS PROTOCOLS ARE COMPLETE TO ALLOW ENTRY INTO THE BUILDING.
- BPE students must be dropped off in the back parking lot and ME students must be dropped off in the front drive facing Alston. (See Map)
- At no time are parents to go through the parking lot and drop students off.
- No cell phone usage while in the school zones.
- Students may only be dropped in the designated areas where staff are present.
- Students may not be dropped off at other areas or entrances around the campus.
- STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR OPENING AND CLOSING THEIR OWN CAR DOOR.
- Please maintain a safe speed in and around our campus. This includes driveways, roads, and parking lots. No child at any point in time is allowed to cross the parking lots.
- PARENTS MAY NOT WALK STUDENTS TO CLASSROOMS.
- ALL CARS MUST HAVE STUDENT NAME AND GRADE LEVEL CLEARLY POSTED IN WINDSHEILD.

DISMISSAL

Carpool Lines (Dismissal) SEE DISMISSAL MAP BELOW

As with our morning arrivals, the following rules apply in the afternoon as well:

- We will be assigning a Barrington Car Rider Line and a Meadows Car Rider Line. A staff member located in the drive will signal each lane when their time to load is permitted. SEE MAP
- IF YOU DRIVE TO THE WRONG SCHOOL LINE, YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO DRIVE TO THE CORRECT SCHOOL LINE AND WAIT. WE CANNOT MOVE CHILDREN FROM ONE SCHOOL LINE AREA TO THE OTHER.
- Please be cognizant of speeds and staff members assisting with car rider duty.
- Students will wait inside until their names(BPE) or numbers (ME) are called.
- All car rider tags must be visible from the front windshield. We suggest using a pant hanger to hang the tags from the rearview mirror.
- No cell phone usage in the school zone.
- Please work with your fellow parents to merge safely.
- Students will be escorted to your car as you wait in line. Please post a sign on your right, front visor indicating their assigned carpool number and/or the names of the students you are picking up.
- STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR OPENING AND CLOSING THEIR OWN CAR DOOR.
- Please maintain a safe speed in our carpool line and parking lot during dismissal times.
- Students waiting in the carpool line will not be dismissed to a parent who walks to the front of the school. You need to pick up your child from the carpool line.
- Students will not be dismissed from the carpool line to a walking parent.

Buses (Arrival)

Students arriving by bus are unloaded on the west side of our campus off of Squire Dobbins Lane. Information on bus routes and approximate pick-up times can be found on the Fort Bend ISD Transportation website at <u>transport.Support@fortbendisd.com</u> or you may call (281)634-4077.

Buses (Dismissal)

Students leaving by bus are loaded on the west side of our campus. Information on bus routes and approximate drop-off times can be found at <u>transport.Support@fortbendisd.com</u> or you may call (281)634-4077. Please keep in mind an adult must be present at the bus stop to be dismissed to that adult. If an adult is not present, your child will remain on the bus and return to campus.

Buses and Daycares



Daycare and Extended Day

<u>Arrival:</u> Daycare AND Extended Day Students will be dropped off on the back ramp AND COMPLETE WELLNESS CHECKS BEFORE ENTRANCE INTO THE BUILDING. All Extended Day students will be escorted to their grade levels at 7:35 a.m. each morning.

<u>Dismissal:</u> All Extended Day students will be escorted to the Extended Day room by the Extended Day staff each afternoon. Parents may use the front parking lot and ramp to pick up their children from Extended Day STARTING AFTER 3:45. Daycare students will load their vans in an orderly manner with staff on the back ramp each day.

WALKERS and BIKERS

WE ARE ASKING THAT DURING THIS TIME WITH REQUIRED HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS, STUDENTS ARRIVE/DISMISS BY CAR WITH A PARENT PRESENT (UNLESS THE STUDENT IS EXTENDED DAY, DAY CARE OR A BUS RIDER) NO WALKERS OR BIKERS, IF POSSIBLE, PLEASE. If you have a student who must walk home, please read the survey closely regarding wait times and staggered dismissal. Please also contact me to discuss logisitics. PreK and K students may not be walkers at dismissal without an older sibling.

RAINY DAY DISMISSAL -- When we do have Rainy Day dismissal, parents are notified via Black Board Messenger with a message to the email address that you have listed in Skyward. ALL students will be car riders, bus, or day care. WE WILL NOT HAVE WALKERS ON RAINY DAY DISMISSAL DAYS. Please have an alternate person to pick up via car if you are unable to.
