

Houston Rockets Read Nation Reading Program: I'm very happy to announce that Settlers Way won 2nd Place in the *Houston Rockets Read Nation Reading Program*!!! We competed with surrounding schools and school districts to see which school could read the most minutes in a designated month. Thanks to all the students who participated. It takes teamwork and Explorers excel at that!

Here are the results for the top three winning schools:

1st place – Turner Elementary, Pasadena ISD - 265,690 total minutes

2nd place - Settlers Way Elementary, Fort Bend ISD - 165,481 total minutes

3rd place - Highlands Elementary, Goose Creek CISD - 164,613 total minutes




