School Supplies

OCE Website – Monthly newsletters and weekly homework will be posted here.


Email – Kindly allow 24 hours for a response from your child's teacher.



Classroom Behavior Chart

Every student has a clip with his/her name on it. Each student's clip starts on Blue Jay Behavior every day. Students have the opportunity to move their clip up or down throughout the day depending upon their choices. Students earn Blue Jay Bucks when they end their day with their clip on Blue Jay Behavior (2), Wow (5) or Double Wow (10).
