




## WORDS OF THE MONTH: CREATIVE & UNIQUE

This February, as part of School Counseling and Random Acts of Kindness Week, Lakeview will launch a school-wide service project called the "Sending Love Campaign." This project supports our SEL work and connects to the FBISD Profile of a Graduate by giving students a real opportunity to practice empathy, kindness, and responsibility in a meaningful way.

Our Vikings will create cards and pictures for seniors living in care facilities and retirement communities ~ many of whom may not receive much mail or regular connection. Through this experience, students learn that small acts of kindness can have a big impact. It also helps Vikings see themselves as servant leaders who can use their time, talents, and words to bring encouragement to others.
