

FORT BEND ISD EXTENDED LEARNING

Extended Day's Summer Programs are designed to provide students with project and inquiry-based activities that call on their critical thinking and collaborative skills. Engaging activities are planned for the entire day with curriculum designed by our talented program staff and supplemented by STEM activities from Camp Invention, a program of Invent Now. Camp invention is led by experienced local educators and new curriculum is introduced each year, inspired by the Inductees of the National Inventors Hallof Fame!

This program is designed for students entering Pre-kand Kindergarten. Students must be 4 years old by September 1st and toileting independently to qualify. Students will have in-house events, splash days, field trips, and lunch provided once per week.

Students who have completed Kindergarten through exiting 5th grade are eligible. There are weekly field trips, in house events, swimming and lunch provided once per week. Studentsentering6-8th grade are eligible for Middle School Camp. Campers will take weekly field trips, participate in fun inhouse events and go swimming weekly. Lunch will be provided once per week.

Summer 2017 Field Trips

Every week students participate in differentfield trips or special events to enhance their summer experience. Students must wear their Extended Day t-shirt on field trip days in order to participate. Each student receives one t-shirt when camp begins. Fees for field trips are included in the cost of the week. Students will attend one field trip per week and are transported in FBISD vehicles. Hours of Operation

The 2017 Summer Program begins Monday, June 5 and ends Friday, August 4; Extended Day is closed on July 4th. There will be 9 one-week sessions. Hours are from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Extended Learning will be closed from August 7-August 21.

Lunch

The program provides lunch one day per week. Parents are responsible for sending lunch and two snacks on all other days.

Swimming

Elementary and middle school students will swim once per week at one of FBISD's aquatic facilities. The swimming schedule will be noted on the campus calendar. Each student must attend the swimming field trip, but are able to sit out from the pool while at the aquatic facility. Students will need appropriate swimwear (one piece swimsuits for girls and swim trunks for boys). No two piece swimsuits are allowed. Students also need to bring a towel, and goggles, if desired.

Registration

Registration opens on April 12 and will be available throughout the duration of the summer. Go to https:// fortbendisd.revtrak.net to register. Once logged into your account, you will need to complete the registration questions for your child(ren) and select the campus and weeks of attendance. Online registration closes at noon the Friday before each session starts. You will be able to go back into your account throughout the summer to add additional sessions as you wish. The answers to the registration questions will be saved from the first time that you completed theform.

Non-FBISD Student Requirements

Bring a copy of up-to-date immunization records to your campus Site Coordinator. This includes Pre-k students.



Fee Information

Each weekly session costs \$125. Full payment is due at the time of registration, but sessions may be selected a week at a time.

Payment is due at the time the session is selected so only register for the sessions you are prepared to pay for immediately. Parents may register online throughout the summer.

There is a \$50 non-refundable and non-transferable registration fee. The registration fee is paid one time per summer regardless of the number of sessions attending.

Payments can be made online via a credit or debit card.

Sites are not permitted to accept registration or payments.

Refund Process

Requests for refunds must be submitted in writing and received by the Extended Learning Department Main Office at least 10 days before the session begins. No refunds will be given for requests that are received after the deadline, regardless of the child's attendance.

Refunds can take up to 4 weeks to process. The registration fee is not refundable for ANY reason.
