Safety Protocols

- ▶ Frequent handwashing, hand sanitizing
- ▶ Physical distancing
 - ▶ Hallways, restrooms, classrooms, lunch, etc.
- ▶ Mask wearing
 - ▶ Over mouth and nose at all times in classrooms, hallways, common areas, buses
- ▶ Health screenings, temperature checks
- ▶ Do not come to school if you feel sick!
- ▶ Tell your teacher immediately if you begin to feel sick while at school.

Student Arrival

- ▶ Health screening, temperature checks
- ▶ Bus riders and student drivers will enter via the bus ramp and go directly to the Commons.
- ▶ Walkers, bike riders, & drop-offs will enter via front doors by the flag pole no earlier than 7:00 a.m. & go directly to the Commons.
- ▶ Grab and go breakfast
- ▶ Head to first class at 7:10 a.m. No wandering or hanging out in the hallways!
- ▶ Students who have tutorials or teacher meetings **MUST** have a pass (physical or electronic) in order to enter the building before their designated time.

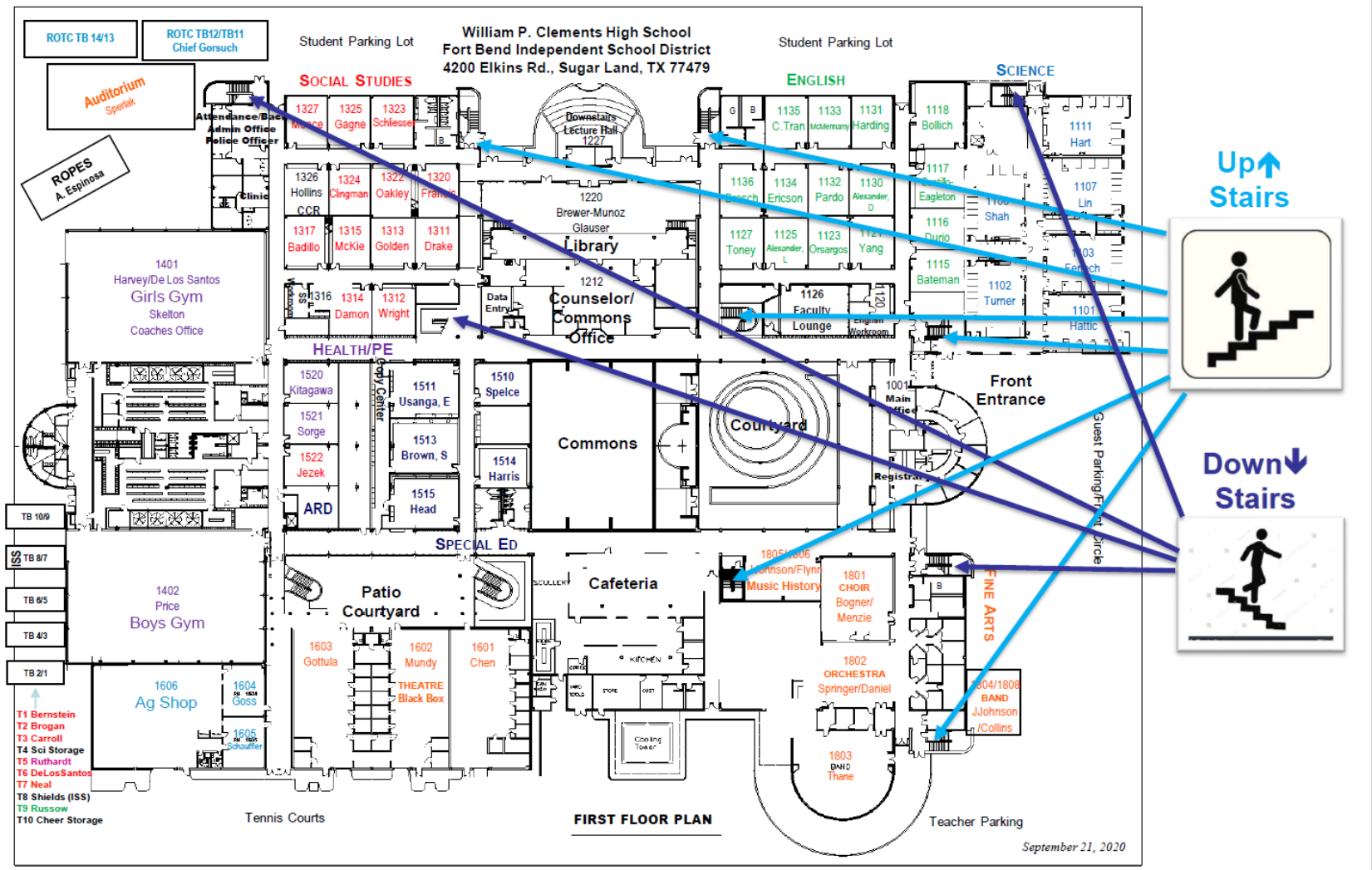
2020-21 F2F Bell Schedule

- ▶ All students head directly to their first classes at the 7:10 A.M. bell.
- ▶ A one-minute warning bell rings prior to the start of each class period (except before the 11:30 tardy bell).
- ▶ A staggered dismissal bell rings after each class (5 minutes after the first dismissal bell) and at the end of the school day (2:48 P.M.).

Passing Periods

- ▶ Staggered Dismissal
 - ▶ 15 minute passing periods
 - ▶ Odd room numbers dismiss first
 - ▶ Even room numbers dismiss five minutes later
 - ▶ Students must report directly to their next class
- ▶ One way staircases
- ▶ Restrooms & Water Fountains
 - ▶ Maintain physical distancing - do not enter restroom if all stalls are full. Wait until someone leaves and then enter; form a line in the hallway with physical distancing as necessary
 - ▶ Only use water fountains to fill water bottles; **NO DRINKING** from water fountains

Lunch

- ▶ Two lunches
- ▶ Grab and Go meals from cafeteria (free!)
 - ▶ Two lines with physical distancing
 - ▶ Electronic payments encouraged
- ▶ Students only eat in Commons, patio, or courtyard (with physical distancing)
 - ▶ No leaving eating areas or roaming the school
 - ▶ Administrators will dismiss you from lunch
- ▶ Once finished eating, put your mask back on
- ▶ No microwaves available
- ▶ Pick up your trash, please!

Student Dismissal

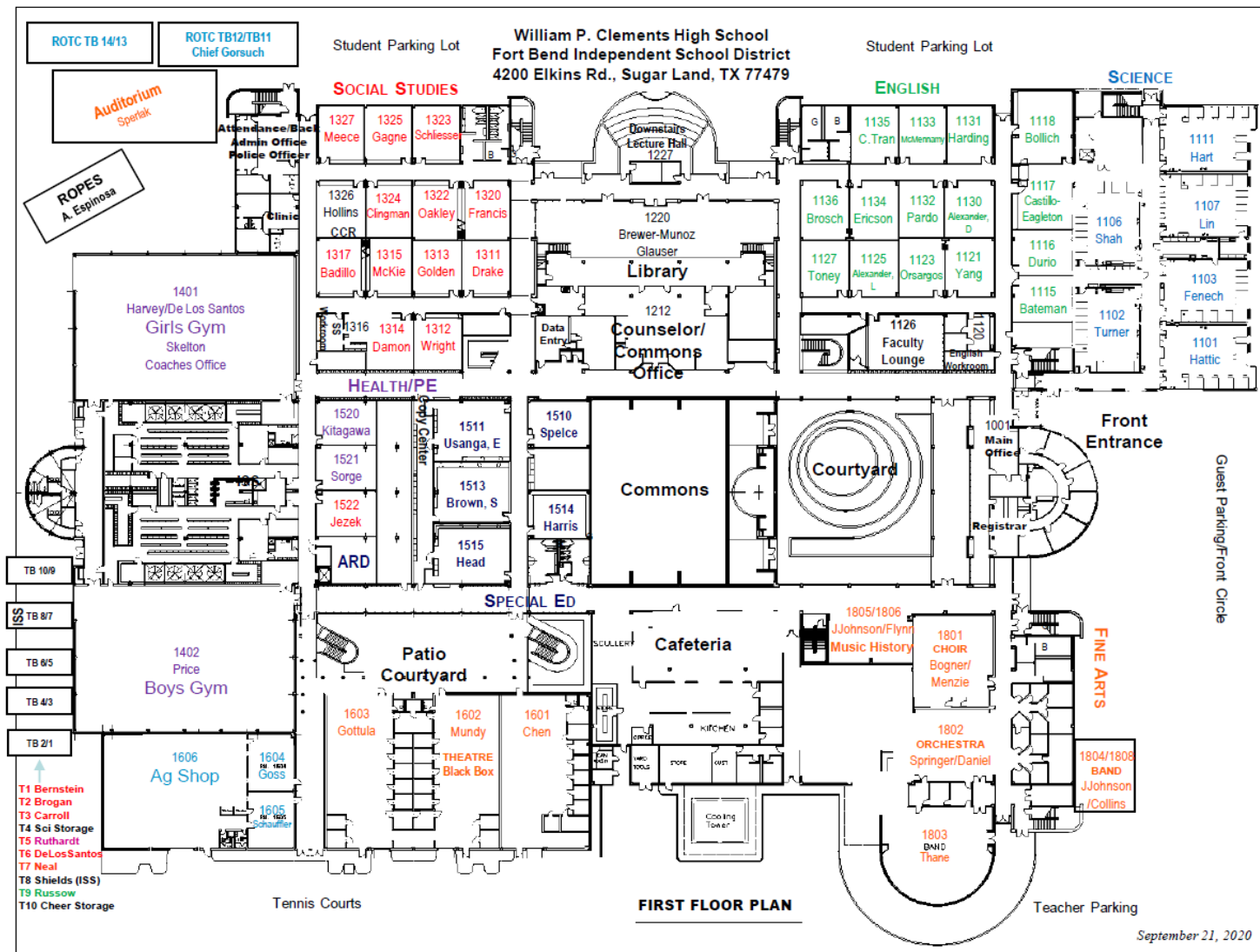
- ▶ Staggered Dismissal
 - ▶ Odd room numbers dismiss first at 2:45
 - ▶ Even room numbers dismiss three minutes later
- ▶ All students must clear the building by 3:00 p.m.
- ▶ Students who have tutorials or a meeting **MUST** have a pass (physical or electronic) in order to remain in the building after 3:00 p.m.

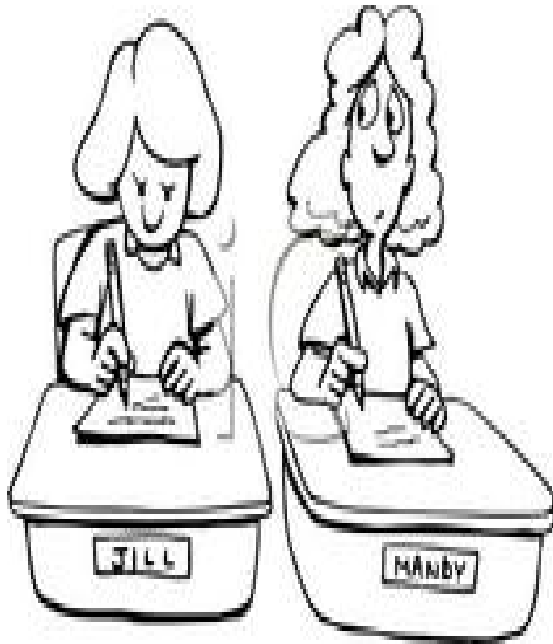

What is Academic Dishonesty?

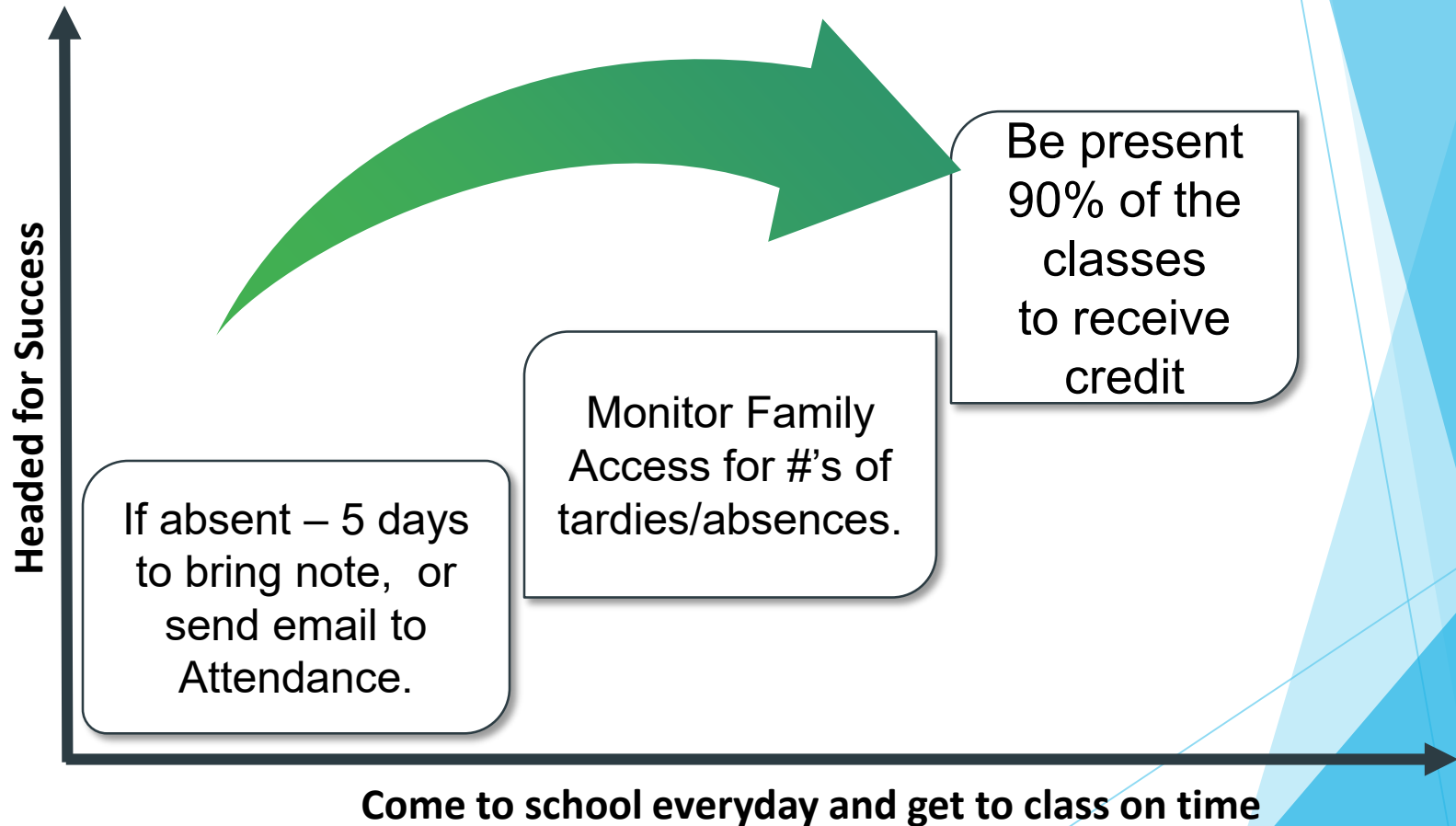
Violations of Academic Integrity Policy may result in:

- ▶ Grade reductions and zeroes
- ▶ Loss of membership in organizations
- ▶ Inability to get teacher recommendations and scholarships for college
- ▶ Loss of test privileges with College Board
- ▶ In school suspension
- ▶ Alternative school

Attendance, Safety, Parking



Tardies

- ▶ 3 tardies = first referral
 - ▶ Each additional tardy = another referral
- ▶ Consequences:
 - ▶ AM/PM detention
 - ▶ Saturday detention
 - ▶ In school suspension

Driving Privileges and Parking at CHS

- ▶ Parking on campus is a privilege
- ▶ Parking pass - Mrs. Lavine (Commons Office)
- ▶ Parking lot locations
- ▶ Parking restrictions

Code of Conduct Violations

- ▶ Investigations and searches
- ▶ Off campus school activities are still considered 'ON CAMPUS' for discipline.
- ▶ Police officers on campus: Officer Villarreal/Officer Chapman

Criminal Referrals

- ▶ Discipline violations may result in criminal referrals
 - ▶ Examples: assault, drug possession/vaping
- ▶ Code of Conduct violation
 - ▶ Misdemeanor
 - ▶ Felony

Consequences of Criminal Referrals

- ▶ Alternative School
- ▶ Arrest
- ▶ Jail
- ▶ Impact of felony convictions
