COURSES OFFERED:

Incoming 9th graders can only take Pre-AP Geometry (Algebra I is the prerequisite) or Pre-AP Computer Science. Pre-AP Pre-Calculus, Pre-AP Computer Science, AP Psychology and AP Human Geography are available to incoming 10th – 12th graders. AP Government and AP Economics are available to incoming seniors

Attendance for the complete term is required for course credit.

- 1.0 Credit Courses = \$700 (FBISD students) \$350 (FBISD students served by the Federal Free/Reduced Lunch Program)
- .5 Credit Courses = \$500 (FBISD students) \$250 (FBISD students served by the Federal Free/Reduced Lunch Program)

Cost includes textbooks, instructional resource materials, and laboratory related resources for science courses.

REGISTRATION Online: April 22nd at 12:00 Noon — June 4th at 12:00 Midnight (No walk-in registration is available.) Registration for all courses is on a first come first served basis and will depend on the availability of qualified teachers. Registration information is available from the school counselor or online. Parents/students needing assistance with registration or paying by cash should visit their campus counselor. As courses fill, they will no longer be available for registration. Guidelines for grades, dress code, and discipline are included in the High School Summer School Brochure.

All online registrations without payments will be **dropped within 24** hours of a course selection. Any remaining unpaid courses will be dropped on **June 4**th at 12 Midnight.

Refund requests will not be accepted or approved once classes begin on the first day of each session. There will be a \$25 processing fee deducted from all requested/approved re-funds, unless due to class closure by administration. Refunds may take up to four (4) weeks to process.

Special Note: All online registration (course selection) without payment is subject to being dropped without notice. Parents and students are encouraged to pay at the time the course is selected in Family Access in order to avoid being dropped from the course. Online course selections will not be held without payment. If students are dropped from the course they previously selected, the course will need to be selected again in Family Access before payment is accepted online.

ELIGIBILITY: Pre-AP and AP courses offered during the summer will be open to incoming 9th through 12th grade students. Students must meet all necessary prerequisite requirements for enrollment in a course.

EXPECTATIONS: These courses are designed to prepare students for the next level of study in a discipline and for successful performance on an Advanced Placement Exam. Courses are academically challenging and will require study and preparation time outside of class. Students are advised to limit other summer obligations during the period they will be attending class.

ATTENDANCE POLICY: Efficient use of class time is essential to the student's success. Students will be withdrawn without receiving credit for the course if they have more than two (2) absences during a session, regardless of the date of the third absence. A student is marked absent after missing the first 30 minutes of a class. Three tardies in a class will be counted as one (1) absence. Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for excessive absences/tardiness.

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: The last day to withdraw from the course without impact on the high school transcript/GPA will be June 17. Transcripts for 1st session students withdrawing after June 17 will reflect a course grade of 50 at the time of withdrawal. Transcripts for 2nd session students withdrawing after July 15 will reflect a course grade of 50 at the time of withdrawal. No refunds will be given for withdrawal from the course.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation is not provided for pre-AP and AP courses offered during the summer.

PAYMENT: Online payment can be made with a credit or debit card after the courses have been selected in Family Access. For cash payments, parents or students may visit their school counselor.

Out of district students are able to attend FBISD General Summer School programs and will register on June 4th from 8 am to 11 am. An additional \$100 administration fee will apply unless parent/guardian is able to verify residence (a utility bill may be used for verification).
