Summer Middle School Programs

2019 Middle School Remedial Course Offerings

The Remedial Middle School program will be offered in one session. Two courses can be taken during the session. Students who need to repeat two courses must successfully complete both courses in order to be promoted to the next grade level based on grade placement committee decisions.

Summer School is offered to students who did not successfully complete courses previously taken in grades 6, 7 or 8 during the 2018-2019 school year that are needed to be promoted to the next grade level.

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Program Information

Pre-AP High School Courses

Incoming ninth graders for the 2019-2020 school year may register for Pre-AP Courses: Pre-AP Computer Science or Pre-AP Geometry (if they have successfully completed Algebra I).

Tuition for Pre-AP credit courses for FBISD students toward high school graduation is \$700 per 1.0 credit and \$350 for students who are currently served by the Free and Reduced Lunch Program and transportation is not provided.

Original High School Courses

(Please reference HS Summer School Brochure for more Information.)

Incoming ninth graders for the 2019-2020 school year may register for Original Credit Courses: Art I, Professional Communications (Speech), Health (online only), Foundations of Personal Fitness, or PE during the summer of 2019. Successful completion of each semester (session) earns 0.5 credit towards high school graduation. Registration forms and information are available from your middle school counselor.

Tuition for original credit courses for FBISD students towards high school graduation is \$300 per course (0.5 credit) and \$150 per course (0.5 credit) for students who are currently served by the Free and Reduced Lunch Program and include transportation.

Important Information

Students who took Algebra I as 8th graders and failed one or both semesters have several options for meeting the math standard required for moving to high school.

- If a student failed both semesters of Algebra I and the Algebra I EOC, the student should take 8th grade math in summer school and then repeat Algebra I as a 9th grader to improve their foundation skills.
- If a student failed only one semester of Algebra I and failed the EOC, it may be in the best interest of the student to repeat the entire course next year in 9th grade and take 8th grade math in summer school.
- If a student failed only one semester of Algebra I and passed the EOC, the student may take the failed semester during summer school.
- If a student passed Algebra I and failed the Algebra I EOC, the student may retest in June.
- If you have specific questions, please contact your child's counselor to review the options.

2018 Middle School 8th Grade Accelerated Instruction Program

The Student Accelerated Instruction Program is designed to provide students the opportunity to be academically successful on the third administration of the Reading and Math STAAR assessment. This program will be offered to current eighth graders. Middle school counselors will submit qualified students to summer school administrators for registration. There is no tuition for this program.

No fee is charged for Accelerated Instruction 8th Grade Program and transportation is included.

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Registration Process

- Online Registration
- Dates: May 6, 2019 through June 4, 2019

Special Note: All online registration without payment is subject to being dropped without notice. Parents and students are encouraged to pay soon after the time the counselor has enrolled them in the summer school course in order to avoid being dropped from the course. Online course selections will not be held without payment. If students are dropped from the course they previously selected, the course will need to be selected again by the counselor in Family Access before payment is accepted online.

Students must complete registration form and return form to the campus counseling office before selecting and paying online.

Students/Parents will need to pay online with a credit/debit card through Fort Bend ISD's Family Access after the counselor has enrolled the student in the appropriate courses – go to www.fortbendisd.com (Family Access is an icon at the top right side of the home page.). Parents/students needing assistance with registration or paying by cash should visit their campus counselor.

**Out of district students are able to attend FBISD General Summer School programs and will register on June 4, 2019 from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM. Location is 555 Julie Rivers Drive Sugar Land, TX 77478 in room 128. An additional \$100 administration fee will apply unless parent/guardian is able to verify residence (utility bill may be used for verification).*

REGISTRATION FOR ALL COURSES IS ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVED BASIS AND WILL DEPEND ON THE AVAILABILITY OF QUALIFIED TEACHERS.

Space is limited, and some courses will close before the registration end date (June 4, 2019).

Payment Information

Online registration and payments are highly encouraged with use of credit/debit card. Cash payments may be accepted at the student's campus.

- Payment must be made in cash or by credit/debit card. Checks will not be accepted. Full payment is required at the time of registration. Refund requests will not be accepted or approved once classes begin on the first day of each session. There will be a \$25 processing fee deducted from all requested/approved refunds, unless due to class closure by administration. Refunds may take up to four (4) weeks to process.

THERE IS NO LATE REGISTRATION FOR THE SECONDARY SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM.

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Important Information

- **Class Assignments** - Classes are assigned by the summer school administrative team based on enrollment, need, and the availability of certified teachers. Courses that are cancelled due to insufficient enrollment or lack of certified teachers will result in a full refund or the opportunity for the student to select another available course.
- **Grades** - Progress reports will be given to students for Session I and Session II on the seventh day of each session. Final grades **will be mailed** to the student's home at the conclusion of each session.
- **Attendance Procedures** - Efficient use of class time is essential to the student's success. Students will be withdrawn without receiving credit for the course if they have more than two (2) absences during a session, regardless of the date of the third absence. A student is marked absent after missing the first 30 minutes of a class. Three tardies in a class will be counted as one (1) absence. **Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for excessive absences/tardiness.**
- **Dress Code** - All students attending summer school in FBISD are required to follow the FBISD dress code and grooming policies. Students receiving a second (2nd) warning will be withdrawn from summer school without receiving a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session on which the incident occurs. **Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for dress and grooming violations.**
- **Discipline Guidelines** - All students will follow the FBISD Student Code of Conduct. Students refusing to adhere to the code of conduct who receive a second (2nd) discipline referral will be withdrawn from summer school without receiving a grade for the session regardless of the date within the session. In addition, physical and/or verbal confrontations on campus or on the school bus, which are deemed to cause a major disruption of the educational environment and/or impair the driver's operation of the school bus, **will result in the student being immediately withdrawn from summer school.** This action will be taken without receipt of a grade/credit for the session regardless of the date within the session on which the incident occurs. **Refunds will not be given to students who are withdrawn for discipline reasons.**

Transportation

Transportation will be provided for FBISD summer school students. Pickup and drop-off locations will be provided during registration. Bus stops during the summer will be at cluster elementary locations.

Refund Procedures - Students who are withdrawn from summer school or removed from the bus for disciplinary reasons, or who are withdrawn because of excessive tardiness/ absences, **will not** receive any refund for fees paid on behalf of the student. Refunds **will not** be given once classes begin on the first day of each summer school session.

All allowable requests for refunds must be made in writing to the summer school principal and approved by the principal.

A \$25 processing fee will be deducted from each approved refund. Refunds will be given due to the cancellation of classes and will not be subject to a processing fee. **Allow up to 4 weeks processing time.**
