Business & Community Partnerships Snapshots

Business and Community Partners



Fort Bend ISD values the link between school and community. Business and community partners, non-profit, faith-based and civic organizations bring their resources to the district to enhance and expand the quality of education. FBISD encourages these groups to creatively

partner with campuses to support the district mission and vision statements. Partners have an opportunity to experience the challenges and rewards of teaching and see where they can support campuses with monetary or in-kind donations.

Five Fort Bend ISD schools received backpacks filled with school supplies from the **City of Houston** as part of Mayor Annise Parker's backpack giveaway program. Receiving 25 backpacks each were: Blue Ridge, Briargate, Ridgegate and Ridgemont Elementary Schools, and the Ridgemont Early Childhood Center. Houston City Council Member, Larry Green (District K) joined his staff members in delivering the backpacks to the campuses just in time for the start of the new school year.

Fairmount Minerals Foundation awarded a \$25,000 grant to Sartartia Middle School to assist the school in creating a "Mac Lab." The grant provides funding for the purchase of 15 iMac computers fully stocked with video editing and graphic design software, as well as camera, lighting, sound, and grip gear for the school's newly-formed Media Production Department.

For the past two years, **Fluor, Inc.** has donated backpacks and the needed school supplies to each student at Hunters Glen Elementary on the first day of school. This helps the school "hit the ground" running in regards to teaching and everyone being on the same page. In addition

to receiving the backpacks, the school also received a check for \$4,136 to apply toward the purchase of classroom materials to support instruction in math, science and technology. Fluor also adopted eight Hunters Glen families during Christmas and provided them with books, bikes, video games, clothes, and gift cards. Fluor also sponsored Science Night and volunteered to be Science Fair Judges at the school.

Walmart, located on Hwy 90 and Hwy 6 in Sugar Land, continues its partnership with Lakeview Elementary School. Beth Mullins, School Counselor, wrote, "Walmart has been there to help us in many ways. This year they have furnished us with school supplies, including notebooks, paper, pencils, pens, crayons, glue sticks, scissors, binders, book covers, lunch kits and backpacks. They have also helped us by contributing gift cards to purchase items to help teachers in their classrooms. When we need them, they have been there."

Glover Elementary School hosted its first Family Fitness Night that welcomed more than 200 community members to the campus for a social gathering to promote healthy eating and exercise. Among the area business and

community organizations to take part in the event were **UnitedHealthcare, Walgreens, Simply Fit, Lemke Orthodontics, Stafford Boys and Girls Club, Missouri City Parks and Recreation, My Fit Foods, Zeal, Women's Specialty Healthcare, and Missouri City Middle School's Teens Against Tobacco Use (TATU) Club.**

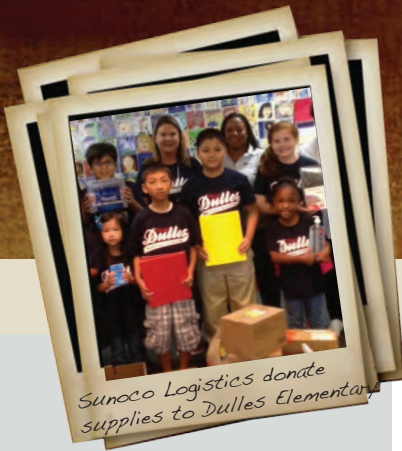

Youngsters at Ridgemont Elementary and Early Childhood Center will receive new school uniforms thanks to the generous donation of a \$5,000 AFL-CIO Adopt-a-School grant from the **Fort Bend Employees Federation**. Ridgemont is one of only 21 schools across the U.S. to receive the grant. Members of the Fort Bend Employees Federation will continue their partnership with Ridgemont Elementary and Early Childhood Center by supporting the school as mentors, tutors and volunteers.

Fort Bend ISD administrators teamed up with the **Houston Department of Health and Human Services (HDHHS)** and the charitable foundation **OneSight** to provide more than 700 FBISD students with free eye exams and eyewear. Students received comprehensive vision exams that included testing for disease, color blindness, depth perception, eye

muscle balance and the need for eyewear prescription. Following their exams, students were able to select from a variety of frames that EyeVan's lab technicians then used to make their eyeglasses.

Recipe for Success instructors joined teachers at Heritage Rose Elementary School in teaching second-grade students how to grow, harvest, and cook their own healthy meals. Funded by a United Health Foundation grant, the program at Heritage Rose introduced students to the entire cycle of food, and empowered them to prepare healthy meals and snacks for themselves. For 10 weeks during the spring semester, Recipe for Success instructors Emily Blakely and Ruth Riojas taught students lessons from the "Seed-to-Plate" Nutrition Education program. Students learned to identify the various parts of vegetable and fruit plants and how to grow their own produce. They also learned about taste and flavor combinations, cooking techniques, and skills that will serve them throughout their lifetimes.

Business and Community Partners



Students at Dulles Elementary School made good use of the school supplies they received from **Sunoco Logistics**. Employees at the company held a school supply drive at their worksite to collect notebook paper, folders, crayons, hand sanitizer and other items for students. This is the second year that Sunoco Logistics has partnered with Dulles Elementary to support the students.

The Oliver Foundation awarded Healthy Choices Grants to three Fort Bend ISD schools – Dulles Middle School, Missouri City Middle School and Oyster Creek Elementary School – to support their efforts in developing innovative programs to help improve students' nutrition and physical activity habits. Missouri City received a \$3,000 Campus Grade Level Grant, Oyster Creek received a \$2,000 Campus Grade Level Grant and Dulles received a \$1,000 Individual Teacher Grant.

The Woman's Club of Missouri City awarded 2013 WCMC Legacy Scholarships to six Fort Bend ISD students, marking the 10th anniversary of the WCMC Legacy Scholarship program. Over the past 10 years, WCMC has awarded \$50,000 in scholarships to Missouri City high school graduates. The 2013 WCMC Legacy Scholars included: Milan Doshi, Elkins High School; Tasia Isbell (also the Jo Butterfield scholarship

winner), Hightower High School; Ena Ganguly, Hightower High School; Imani Butler, Hightower High School; Cortnee Cooper, Hightower High School; and Tyler Caldwell, Ridge Point High School.

Students at Clements High School and Sartartia Middle School are benefiting from Fort Bend Education Foundation grants funded by **Schlumberger**. Clements received a \$15.7 million grant to fund a pilot program that assists computer science students in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) labs. Sartartia received a \$20,000 grant to support the school's Robotics and Programming Club in promoting student learning in programs such as Scratch, Alice and Lego Mindstorms.

To support Fort Bend ISD's efforts in preparing students for successful entry into their postsecondary stage of learning, **Wells Fargo-Southwest Houston Division** generously donated 5,000 college planning resource guides to the District. The resource guides contain information on choosing a college, applying for scholarships and student loans, comparing award letters, completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and more.

Sixteen underserved Briargate Elementary School families received an enjoyable holiday season thanks to members of four area churches -

Mosaic Community Covenant Church, The Way Interdenominational Church, Embassy Covenant Church and Access Seventh-Day Adventist Church. On December 23, members of the four churches united to provide the families with a Christmas dinner, two wrapped gifts for their children, and a \$50 Walmart gift card.

Iris Galvan of **The Boys & Girls Club**, and Eric Wong of **Baskin Robbins**, have been gracious partners to Ridgeway Elementary School. They each serve on the school's Campus-based Leadership Team and give 100 percent of their efforts in providing time, talent and treasures to the school community. They also provide many incentives and chair social events to help raise funds for the school.

For the past four years, **Spring Creek Barbeque** has donated a \$10 gift certificate to every Fort Bend ISD employee. Thank you for your generosity!

Eighth-grade students in Fort Bend ISD, as well as some elementary school students, had the opportunity to explore career paths by taking part in Annual Career Day programs at their campuses. Career Day gives students the opportunity to interact with area professionals to receive first-hand knowledge of various career industries and learn about the preparation needed to pursue desired careers. Students also have the opportunity to increase their awareness of extended learning opportunities, such as service learning and internships.

Students welcomed area business and community leaders, who led informative presentations relating to such industries as law enforcement, engineering, medical, real estate, and government. They also enjoyed guest speakers during morning or afternoon assemblies and Career Education Fairs that featured interactive displays hosted by local companies, FBISD Academies, high school JROTC Programs, and the Technical Education Center.

This year, FBISD approached **Junior Achievement** to help create a new interactive piece for Middle School Career Day to replace the Countdown to Your Future presentation. Junior Achievement worked with **CenterPoint Energy** volunteers and created a short DVD, *Your Career, Your Future*. After having watched the 15 minute movie, students then played JA's board game, *Balance, Break Even, or Broke!* This proved to be a challenging and thought provoking exercise which resulted in some lively discussions.

To celebrate the valuable contributions of its community volunteers, **Armstrong Elementary School** hosted an appreciation breakfast that welcomed members of **First United Methodist Church** and several parent volunteers who are actively involved at the school. The volunteers support Armstrong faculty and staff by serving as mentors, reading buddies, field trip chaperones, and by donating reading material, school supplies and funding to support various programs and activities. Parent participation at **Austin Parkway Elementary School** is at an all-time high, especially with dads and father-figures taking part in the **WatchDOGS** (Dads of Great Students) program. More than 100 dads committed to volunteering more than 60 days on campus during the school year. Fort Bend ISD is fortunate to have a dedicated group of mentors as diverse as the district itself, who get together weekly with students to

help meet their social and academic needs. All mentors share a common desire to see our students succeed, believe every child can learn, and are willing to invest time and energy into the relationship.

A good mentor relationship does not happen overnight: it takes time to build trust and develop a bond between

the mentor and mentee. As one counselor remarked, "It's like throwing a pebble into a pond – you never know where the ripples will stop." Even though mentors might not see results as quickly as they would like, it is important to have faith you are having a dramatic effect on the mentee's life.

Research shows that mentoring works. Students in mentoring programs usually have better attendance, a better attitude to school, make better grades, and their self-esteem improves. Working with the campus counselor and mentee's teacher, a mentor can make a difference, one child at a time.

FBISD's Volunteers/Partnerships Department hosted a Mentor Appreciation and Roundtable Discussion to welcome District mentors to network, share success stories and seek advice from each other in addressing their mentees. FBISD mentors devote at least 30 minutes a week to their mentees, providing them with the added support they need to be successful at school, at home and in the community.



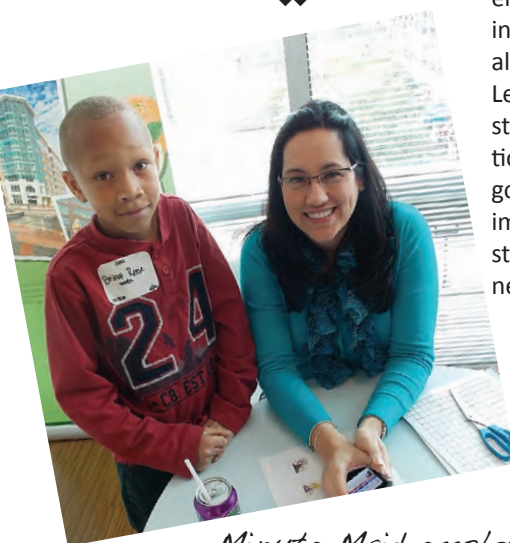
Leading young men through rites of passage is the focus of a unique partnership between **Junior Achievement (JA)** and Marshall High School. To ensure that approximately 50 junior and senior male students receive the added support, encouragement and guidance they deserve, Junior Achievement volunteers have committed themselves to meeting with the students throughout the school year. The students in turn serve as mentors to elementary school students in their feeder patterns. JA also hosted a Young Men's Leadership Conference for the students to enjoy presentations on leadership, success, goal-setting and personal image. The event provided the students with a mentoring and networking experience.



Dulles Elementary School students are benefitting greatly from a rewarding school and business partnership between the school and **Minute Maid**. Employees at Minute Maid have committed themselves to volunteering their time to mentoring approximately 15 students at the school through the **Big Brothers, Big Sisters** program, "Beyond School Walls." The mentors meet with the students at least twice a month throughout the year and will continue with the students as needed throughout their elementary school stay.



Quail Valley Elementary School (QVE) hosted an Ice Cream Social prior to the end of the school year to thank its volunteers for contributing to the school's successful mentoring program. QVE mentors committed a minimum of 30 minutes a week to meeting with students who benefitted greatly from the added guidance, support and encouragement provided by the adult volunteers. The Ice Cream social gave mentors an opportunity to enjoy the company of their mentees one final time before the end of school and socialize with their peers.

Shared Dreams

The Shared Dreams Program “Where Children Remain our Focus”

The Shared Dreams Program provides short term assistance to FBISD students by providing adequate clothing, shoes, school supplies, and toiletries. This program is unique to FBISD and relies solely on monetary and in-kind donations from campuses, parents, and community partnerships.

Fort Bend ISD extends heartfelt thanks to all the parents, business and community partners, faith-based and charitable organizations that help support this program. The Shared Dreams Program has assisted almost **1,000** students this year.

Last December, Holiday Cheer, a Shared Dreams program, made the holidays brighter for **39** FBISD families which included **142** children, **44** sponsors, **31** of whom were returning sponsors and generously provided gifts and gift cards for the children.



Fort Bend ISD's Shared Dreams Program was the proud recipient of more than \$500 worth of school supplies donated by employees of **Aetna, Inc.** Each summer, Aetna hosts a school supply drive where employees collect boxes full of writing tablets, notebook paper, pens and pencils, crayons, rulers and other supplies for students to use throughout the school year.



The Shared Dreams Program continues to benefit from the overwhelming generosity of business and community members, who contribute to the program's success. Residents of the **Landmark at Sugar Land apartments** took part in a seven-week school supply drive, led by leasing consultants Jamie Bentley and Rachel Kiser, to benefit Shared Dreams. The residents collected boxes full of crayons, markers, pencils, composition books, notebook paper, folders and other items to distribute to FBISD students through the program.



To support Shared Dreams, students at Travis High School held a toiletry drive and a shoe drive during which community members donated old shoes to be recycled. The money earned from the shoe recycling program will be used to purchase additional items for Shared Dreams.

Students Giving Back

To promote literacy among youngsters and share their love of reading, four Fort Bend ISD schools held a "Kids Helping Kids" book drive to benefit students at **Heritage Rose Elementary School**. Students from **Baines Middle School** and **Schiff, Sienna Crossing** and **Scanlan Oaks Elementary Schools**, as well as members of the Harvest United Methodist Church, donated more than 3,000 new and gently-used books that were distributed to Heritage Rose students during their school's Literacy Night.

More than 50 **Quail Valley Elementary School (QVE)** students, staff and families demonstrated joyful giving by adopting the residents of Park Manor of Quail Valley, a nursing and rehabilitation home, during the holiday season. The QVE group donated items (such as word search books, unscented lotions, puzzles and stationary) and wrapped the gifts before delivering them to the Park Manor residents. They also went caroling along the facility hallways to spread holiday cheer.

Ridge Point High School student **Keith Baker II** of Boy Scout Troop #212 completed his Eagle Scout Project. He led his Troop and a host of community volunteers in a beautification project for Beth Jacob Cemetery, which belongs to the United Orthodox Synagogue of Houston. Baker and his fellow Troop members cleared the back area of the cemetery of trash and debris, and helped haul the items to a nearby solid waste management depository site.

Fifteen families throughout the Fort Bend ISD community will benefit from the generosity and caring spirit of **Bush High School students and staff** who took part in the school's Holiday Sleigh project. Initiated by social studies teacher, Jan Robertson, the

annual event provides gifts, toiletries and food items to families identified as needing assistance by Fort Bend ISD social workers.

Twenty-six members of **Garcia Middle School's Male Mentors** organization braved 30 degree temperatures in the winter to collect canned and boxed food items from community members. Clements High School students benefit from \$15.7 million Fort Bend Education Foundation grant funded by Schlumberger

Computer Science students at Clements High School had the opportunity to explore the field of engineering by taking part in a pilot program made possible through a \$15.7 million Fort Bend Education Foundation grant funded generously by Schlumberger.

The pilot program provides educational programs to assist students in STEM (science, technology, engineering and math) labs. Included in the agreement are 25 Licenses for Petrel Software, which support the study of petroleum, earth science and technology, as well as 25 Licenses for Ocean Kit Software that are geared toward science, technology and engineering. Schlumberger also provided a new computer lab equipped with 25 computers.

Participating in the program this year were Clements students enrolled in Computer Science III classes, led by teacher Lubna Lorena. The students benefitted from working with a college-level intern and engineers throughout the school year.

"We are extremely grateful to Schlumberger for their support of our Computer Science program," said Lorena. "I am delighted at the thought of the opportunities that our students will have, the doors which will be opened for them and the learning that will take place. For me personally, this program represents the realization of a dream. I have the means to enhance my instruction and the resources that will allow the Computer Science program to strengthen and grow."

Schlumberger employees understand the importance of sharing their products and expertise to expose students to computer science and engineering. "It is definitely our goal to introduce concepts and partnerships that will encourage students to excel in science, technology, engineering and math (STEM) and continue on to STEM majors and careers," said Paula Harris, Schlumberger's Director of Community Affairs.

Schlumberger currently collaborates with more than 530 universities worldwide in providing this program. Clements is one of only two high schools in the world to pilot the program.
