Policies and Procedures

All school policies will be enforced in this class.

Hall Passes?

- ★ Passes will be issued by the school each term. Once a student uses all of the passes for the class, they will have to wait until the next nine weeks to receive another pass.
- ★ Passes will not be given during the first 10 minutes or last 10 minutes of class.
- ★ Students must request to see a counselor between passing periods. (Guidance counselors will send passes for scheduled meetings, and they can be scheduled during lunch/before or after school)

Entering the room?

- ★ Students are expected to come prepared for class and ready to work. Composition notebooks, sharpened pencils, charged laptop, glue sticks, scissors, etc. should be brought to class each day, unless you are instructed to do otherwise by the teacher.
- ★ Enter the room quietly and calmly before the bell.
- ★ Get all materials before you find your assigned seat, and follow the instructions given on the board, projector, and/or Schoology.
- ★ Warmups will be given daily and collected withing the first 10 minutes of class. Warmups will be averaged.

Throwing things away?

- ★ You don't have to ask.
- ★ Please quietly get up, one at a time, if the teacher is talking to the class wait until finished.

Sharpening your pencil?

- ★ Please make sure you have at least 2 sharpened pencils for the start of class.
- ★ Try to sharpen all pencils before the bell or during group transitions. Please do not sharpen pencils during instruction.
- ★ If the teacher or other students are talking to the class, please wait until they are finished.

Absence/Makeup work
