QVMS Guidelines for Success at Athletic Events

Quail Valley Middle School Parents and Students,

After-school activities are a vital and integral part of a student's education. While many of our students lend their talents as an active participant, some find enjoyment in an auxiliary manner. The support that they show towards their peers is to be commended and appreciated.

Athletic events at the middle school level usually take place in the late afternoon. Spectators that attend events after regular school hours do so of their own free will. While it is convenient for many students to "hang around" until the competition/contest/game begins, it is not encouraged by the school district. There is no staff supervision for student spectators to remain on campus after school ends at 4:20 pm. Parents should accompany students and remain with them during the competition/contest/games, depending on the nature of the event. School transportation is not provided for student spectators, and parents accept the responsibility of obtaining transportation to and from the competition/contest/game for the student. Once the competition/contest/game begins, spectators are monitored by either staff members or game managers. Once the event ends, student spectators are expected to exit and clear the campus within 15 or 20 minutes thereafter.

Parents of students who are unsuccessful in following guidelines communicated by staff will be contacted and asked to pick up their child from the event, and the student may be excluded from the privilege of attending future after-school competitions/contests/games.
