









Step 1


Download Schoology app from Apple App Store or Google Play. When you open the app, you should see this screen.

Step 3


You will be redirected to this **SCHOOLOGY MICROSOFT INTEGRATION** page to login.

xxxxxxxxx1@student.fortbendisd.com


Your **default password** is your computer login password. It should be 6-digits long.



Step 4


After entering your email and password, click **SIGN IN**.




