




In the AVID Elective, students:


- Learn organizational and study skills.

- Participate in enrichment and motivational activities that make them career- and college-ready.




In the AVID Elective, students:


Note-taking, studying, and organizing assignments are explicitly taught alongside other academic behaviors for success in school and life






