- Participate in enrichment and motivational activities that make them career- and college-ready.

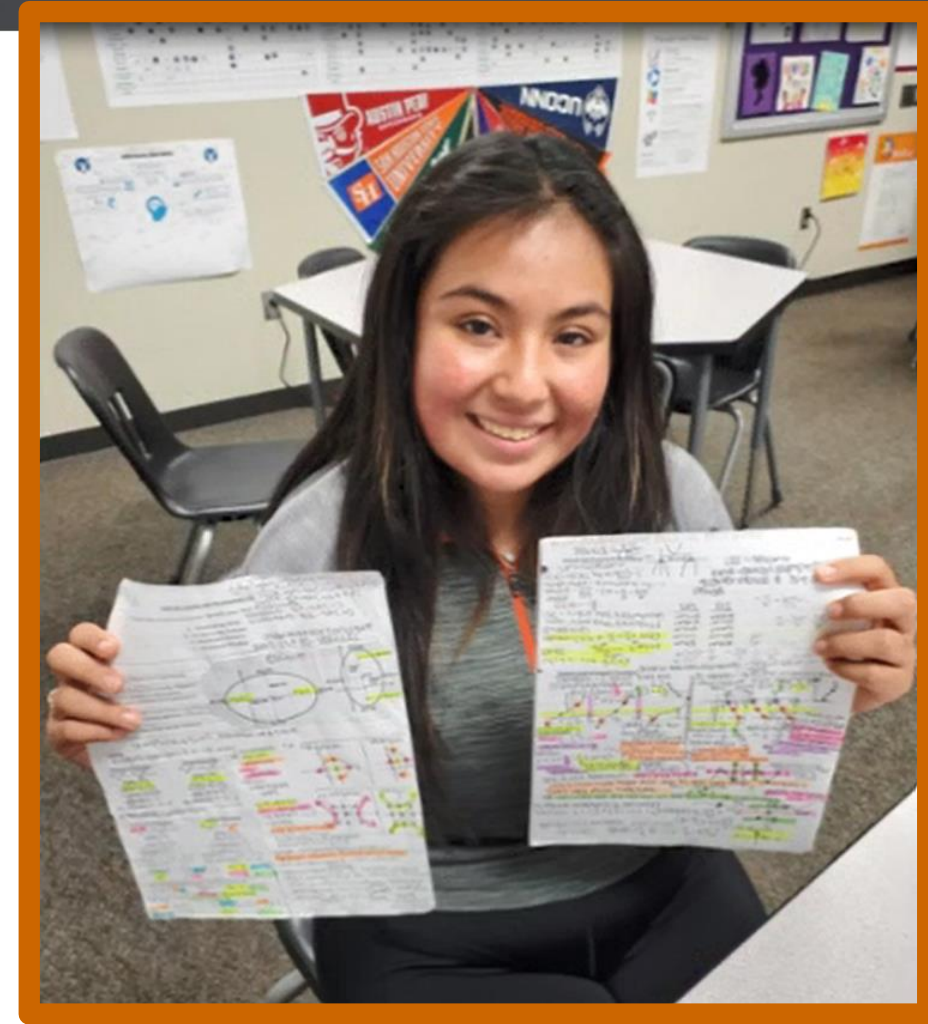
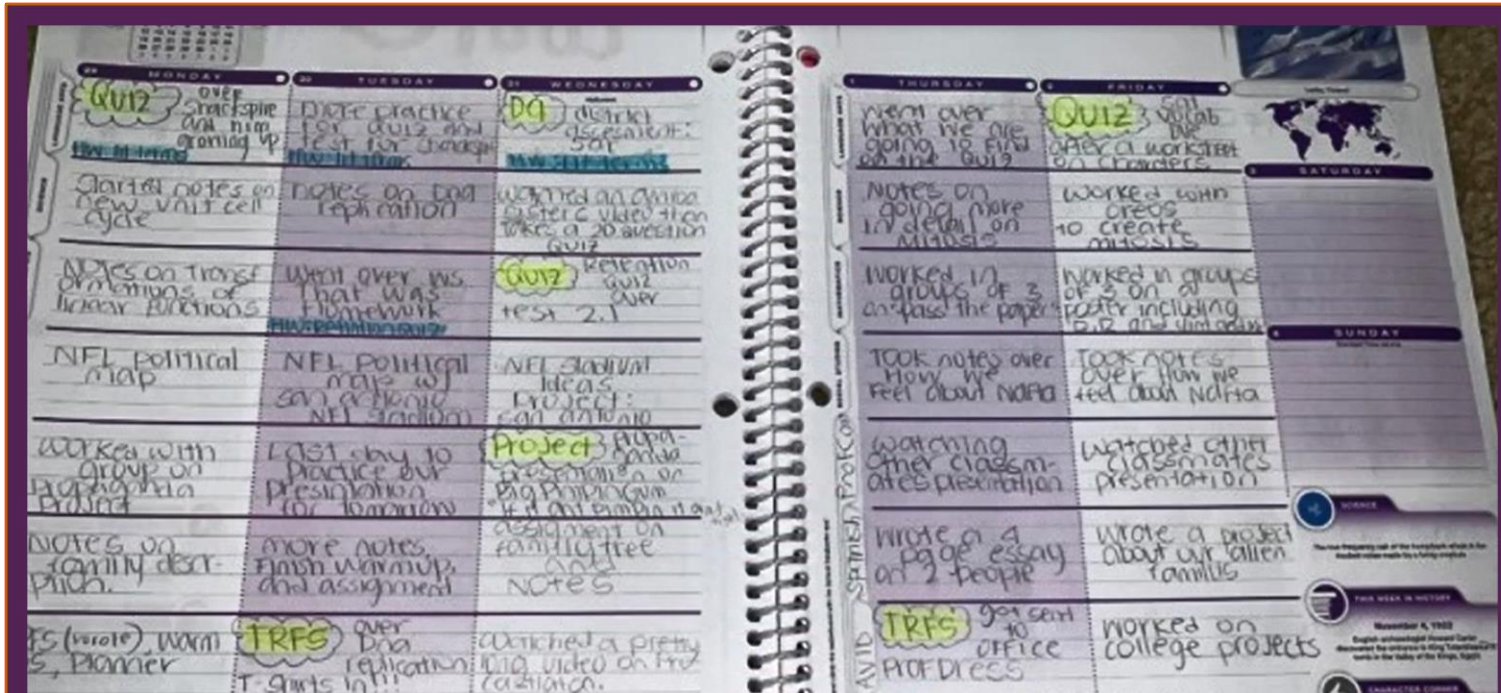

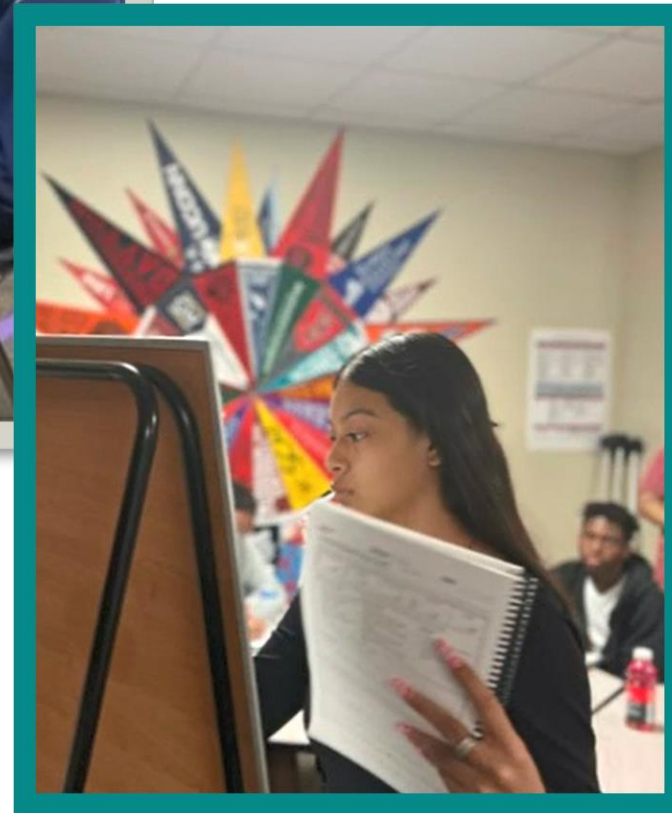
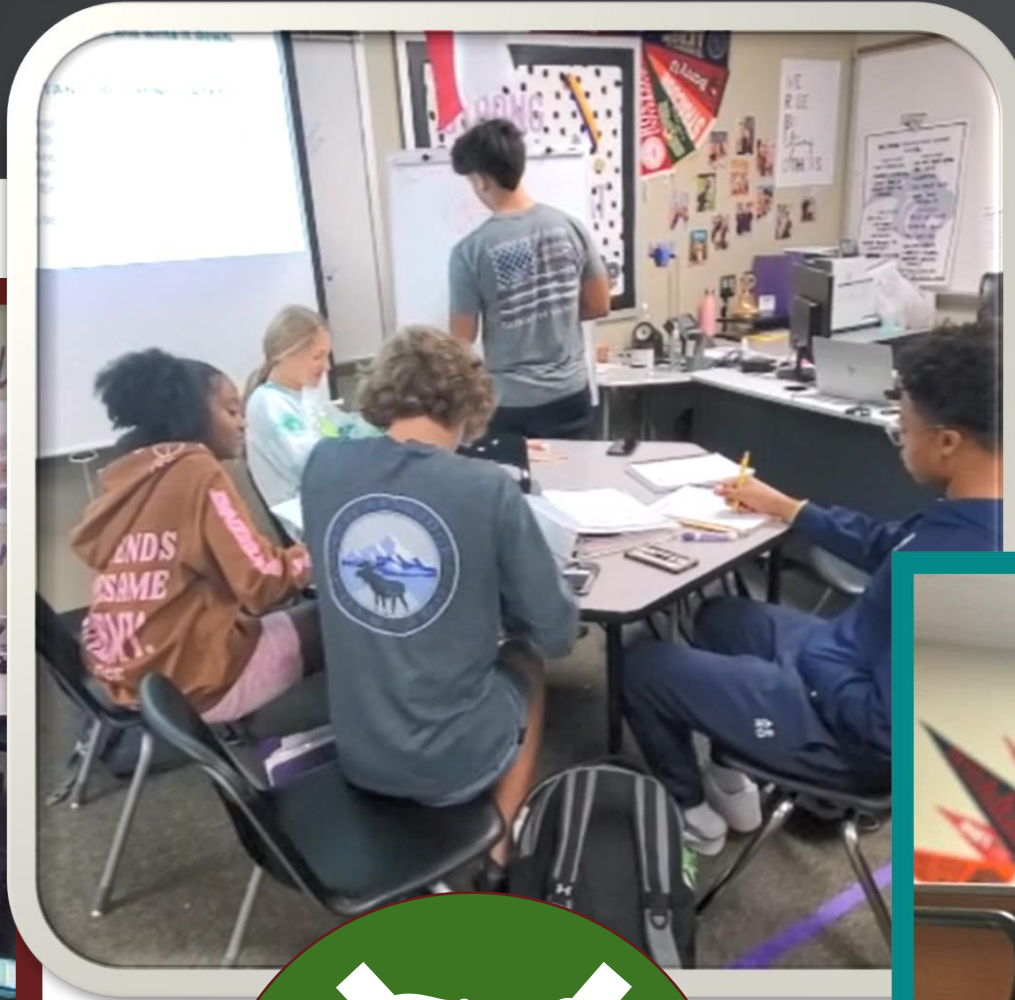
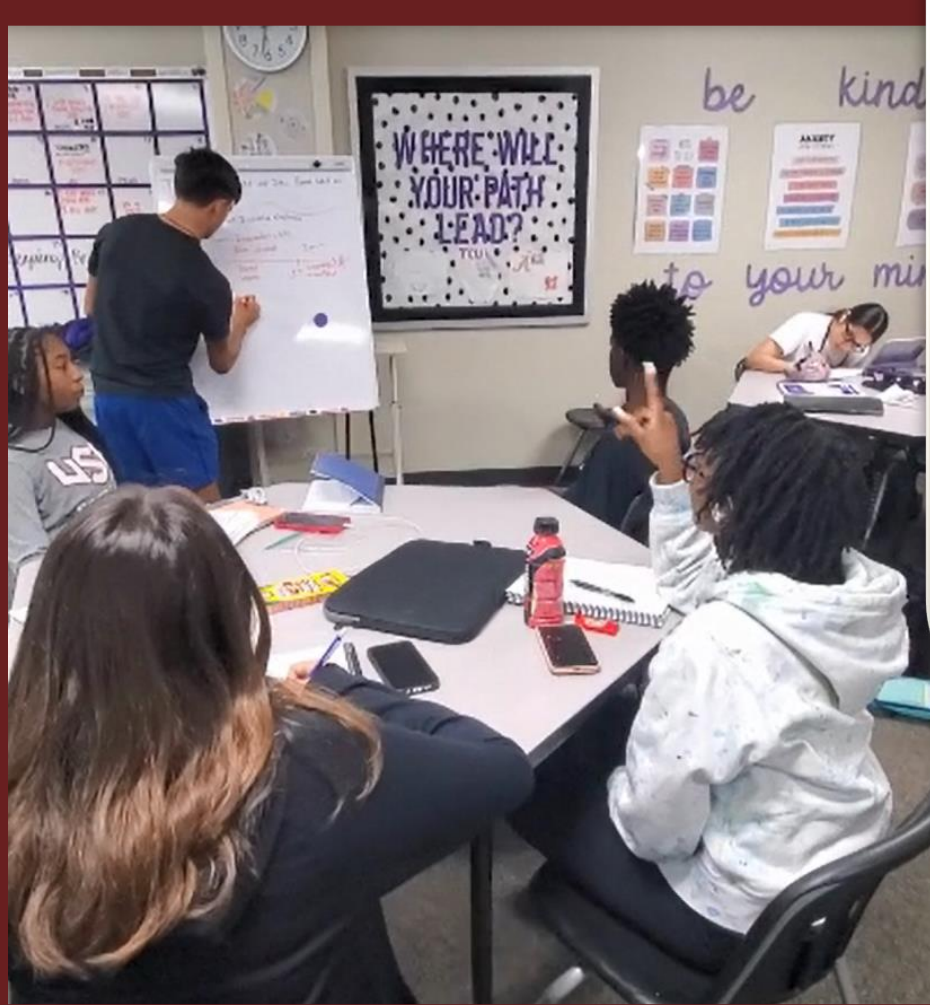
## In the AVID Elective, students:

Note-taking, studying, and organizing assignments are explicitly taught alongside other academic behaviors for success in school and life

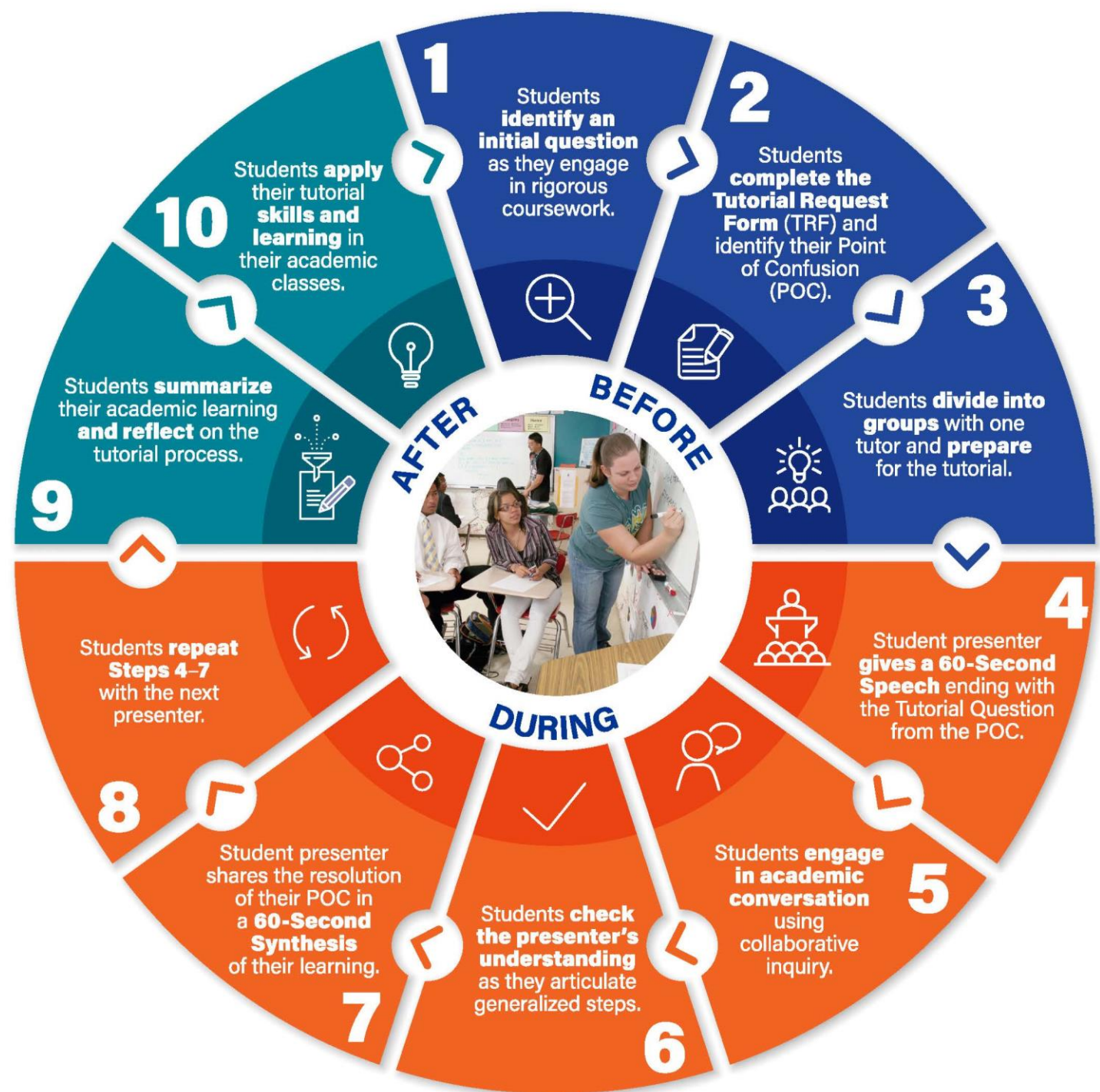

# AVID and ROPES

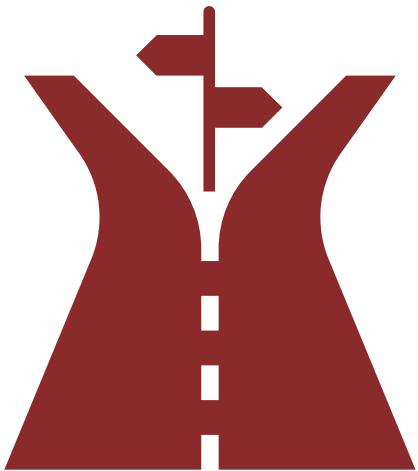
- AVID students engage in experiential learning focused on FBISD's learning dispositions in coordination with AVID curriculum
