Sixth Grade School Supplies

- One 3" D-Ring Binder (Any Color)** - A school-wide personal organization strategy, now in its 3rd year, is that every SLMS student will have what we call an "AVID binder," which is used for all classes. However, this binder should **NOT** be a zip binder, but it does need to be sturdy enough to withstand heavy daily use. In addition to this binder, each student needs to have:
 - 1 set of 5 to 8-Tab Dividers**
 - Heavy-Duty Sheet Protectors**
 - a pencil bag with metal eyelets/grommets (to withstand wear/tear during the year) which will contain these additional supplies:**
 - colored pencils**
 - multicolored highlighters**
 - #2 pencils**
 - glue sticks**
 - scissors**
 - pencil sharpener**
 - ear buds (the kind with a wired connection)**
 - 2 boxes of tissue, 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (to be given to first period teacher on the second day of school)**
