- **How to join:**
 - Be currently enrolled in an English course (unless the highest level of English has already been taken by the student)
 - Teacher recommendation and application required (will be posted on the website and sent out on remind)
- Meetings happen once a month afterschool and are required (day is TBD)
- Dues: \$15 for inducted, \$25 for non-inducted (dues include t-shirt)
