






AVID Results

AVID students complete college entrance requirements at a rate of 2.5 times greater than U.S. students overall.







Considerations for Acceptance into the AVID Program

- Must be enrolled in Advanced Placement classes OR the in the PTech Program
- Priority for those experiencing a challenge that could potentially create roadblocks from enrolling in a four-year college
- Proof of college potential demonstrated in PSAT and/or STAAR scores
- Proof of a Good Academic History in the previous academic year grades
- Intrinsic drive and self motivated to achieve greatness
