- Provide graphic organizers to enhance thinking strategies, self-reflection of reading comprehension, practice for skills taught, and monitor progress.
- Provide manipulatives and graphic organizers to enhance mathematical number sense.

At Home

Hunters Glen Elementary families can support students’ success in reading and math in the following ways:

- Monitor students weekly log and practice
- Sign student’s reading log
- Practice composing and decomposing numbers
- Review practice activities given.

Hunters Glen Elementary Second Grade students will reach success in Reading and Math in the following ways:

- Complete weekly reading passages and questions
- Provide evidence of their thinking by using the graphic organizers to respond to their reading
- Practice homework assignments given
- Use graphic organizer to reflect their problem solving skills on assignments given
